Career in sport

I have been a shooter since 1984 and in the Yugoslav national team since 1987.

As a member of the team I have participated in 5 Olympic Games (Barcelona 1992, Atlanta 1996, Sydney 2002, Beijing 2008 and London 2012) and won many international medals. The most important are:

- World Championships - 5 medals.
- European Championships - 18 medals.
- World Cup Finals: I have won the "Crystal Globe" in 1995 in Munich, and 3rd place in 2011 in Wroclaw
- World Cups - 11 medals.
- Mediterranean Games - 6 medals.
- Multiple champion of the Balkans, Yugoslavia and Serbia.

As a crown of my success, I was chosen the Best Sportsman in Vojvodina in 1995, the Best Sportsman in Novi Sad in 1990, 1991, 1995 and 2008. I have also received several important social acknowledgments and the highest sports title in Yugoslavia and Serbia: the Deserving Sportsman of Yugoslavia.

I have achieved all my success in sport training in Novi Sad, in the Shooting Club "Novi Sad 1790".

Education

I own "B" ISSF coaching license.

I have studied management in sport, tourism and recreation at the Faculty for Business Services in Novi Sad.

Coaching career

I started working as a coach back in 2007 while still actively shooting and competing, I've been working with the shooters as an adviser in modern technologies of training which, besides handling the weapon and shooting strategy, obligatorily include physical preparation, and not as a method of improving results, but as a need to preserve the health of young competitors.

In 2007 I started working as a coach of Esmeri Van Reenen in Republic of South Africa who become from anonymous shooter an Olympian and highly ranked at the ISSF rank list in just eight months. Since then I have been coaching many individual shooters (from beginners to top level). I've also been coaching Oman team in 2013, Ghana team in 2016-2017 and Kenya team in 2017.

Together with Guy Starik from Israel and Snjezana Pejic from Croatia in 2017 I have established 10.9 Synergy coaching team. At our shooting camps in Novi Sad we've been coaching UK team and Singapore team, but we have also organized several shooting camps in Portugal and Norway.

With Italian team I've been working continuously since 2017.

Position in a sports organization

I was engaged in 2001 by Provincial government of Vojvodina region as a consultant for top performance sport's development.

For 5 years (2001-2006) I have worked as Secretary General of the Shooting Association of Vojvodina.

Between 2003 and 2005 I have been a member of the ENGSO (European Non-Governmental Sports Organization) Youth Executive Committee.

Last 12 years (2006 – 2018) I've been the president of "Novi Sad 1790" shooting club.

In May 2004 I've participated in 4-day seminar "European Crossroads – Sport, Front Door to Democracy" in Strasbourg, France, representing the Olympic Committee of Serbia and Montenegro.

In September 2004 I've participated the 1st European Youth Fair Play Congress in Vienna, Austria, also, representing the Olympic Committee of Serbia and Montenegro.

Languages

I speak English and Russian and intensively learn Italian.

I am married and I have two children.
